

## National emergency declaration in USA allows use of squalene

28 October 2009: The decision by President Barack Obama to declare a National Emergency over the swine flu pandemic will allow vaccines and drugs, such as the adjuvant squalene, which have not been approved by the FDA to be used by doctors, hospitals and vaccine clinics. There is a large body of scientific evidence that shows that squalene, in the anthrax vaccine, was responsible for causing the Gulf War Syndrome and other diseases in US and UK soldiers. The swine flu jab vaccine contains up to a million times more squalene than the anthrax vaccines, which afflicted an estimated 25 % of all soldiers who got the jab. Squalene is illegal in the USA and UK, but emergency regulations allow the government to use drugs that have not been proven for safety. - [www.theflu-case.com](http://www.theflu-case.com)

### Chandler firefighters refuse H1N1 vaccine

Phoenix, October 18, 2009: About three-quarters of Chandler firefighters eligible to receive doses from an early batch of the H1N1 flu vaccine have refused it, according to fire department officials.

Most of the 200 doses allocated to the department's roughly equal number of emergency responders likely will be returned to Maricopa County health officials for redistribution to medical professionals, said Marc Walker, a fire department spokesman.

Those who declined the vaccination generally said it was because the vaccine was new and untested.

### Does Flu Vaccine Increase the Risk of Cancer?

The swine flu vaccine has been hit by new cancer fears after a German health expert gave a shock warning about its safety. Dr. Wolfgang Wodarg is a politician and a specialist in lungs, hygiene and environmental medicine. He is the chairman of the health committee in the German parliament and European Council.

Lung specialist Wolfgang Wodarg has said that there are many risks associated with the vaccine for the H1N1 virus. He has grave reservations about the firm Novartis who are developing the vaccine and testing it in Germany. The vaccination is injected "with a very hot needle," Wodarg said.

The solution for the vaccine consists of cancerous cells from animals and "we do not know if there could be an allergic reaction." But more importantly, some people fear that the risk of cancer could be increased by injecting the cells.

The vaccine - as Johannes Löwer, president of the Paul Ehrlich Institute, has pointed out - can also cause worse side effects than the actual swine flu virus.

Wodarg also described people's fear of the pandemic as an "orchestration." Even the pharmaceutical companies are trying to exploit the fear of the swine flu pandemic.

"It is great business for the pharmaceutical industry," he told the 'Neuen Presse.' Swine flu is not very different from normal flu. "On the contrary, if you look at the number of cases, it is nothing compared to a normal flu outbreak," he added.
